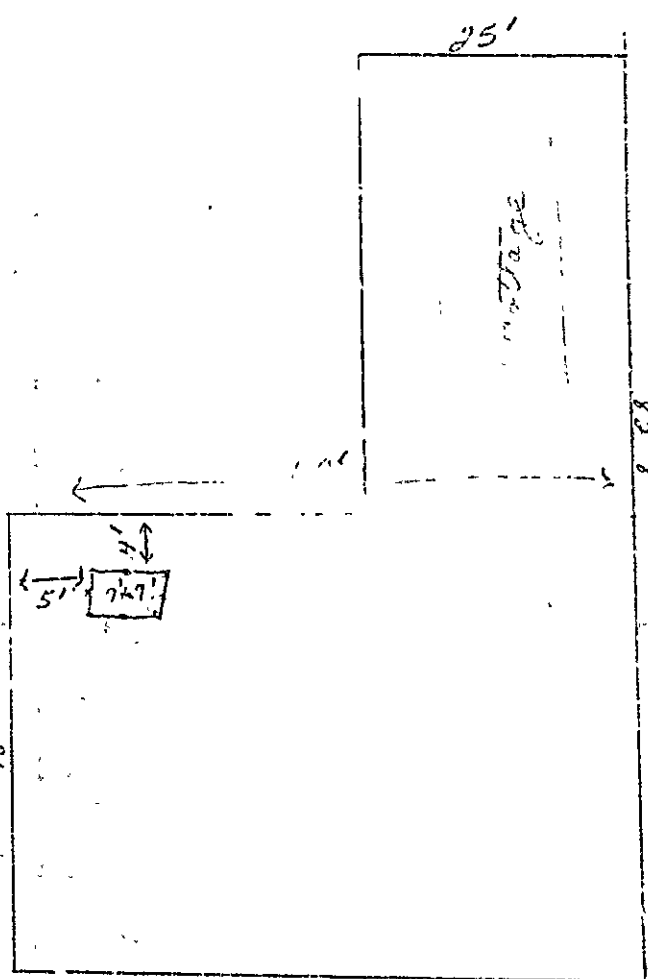

of wood shed----- April 26, 1952

Building permit for construction of a shed 7'x9' for the storage of wood and garden tools on the lot with your cottage on a right of way off Eastern Avenue, Long Island (Assessors' Lot Nos. 104-I-27-28) is issued herewith. The floor framing given of 2x4's, 16" O.C. on a 9' span is not capable of supporting much of a load. We suggest that 2x6's on the same spacing be used or else that if 2x4's are used they be spaced not more than 12" on centers.
