Dear Mr. Billings:

Is it true that a small shed about 7' x 9' has been built on property which you are reported to own or control off Eastern Avenue, Long Island (Assessors Lot No. 104-I-33) and that this shed is built very close if not on the property lines?

If this is true and you are the owner or in control of the property, it is important that you have the building completely removed and the lumber and other building materials neatly disposed of before September 28, 1950.

If our report is true, the building has been built without first securing the required building permit from this department, and is also contrary to the Zoning Law because it is built too close to the property lines.

It is not now acceptable to apply for a belated permit.

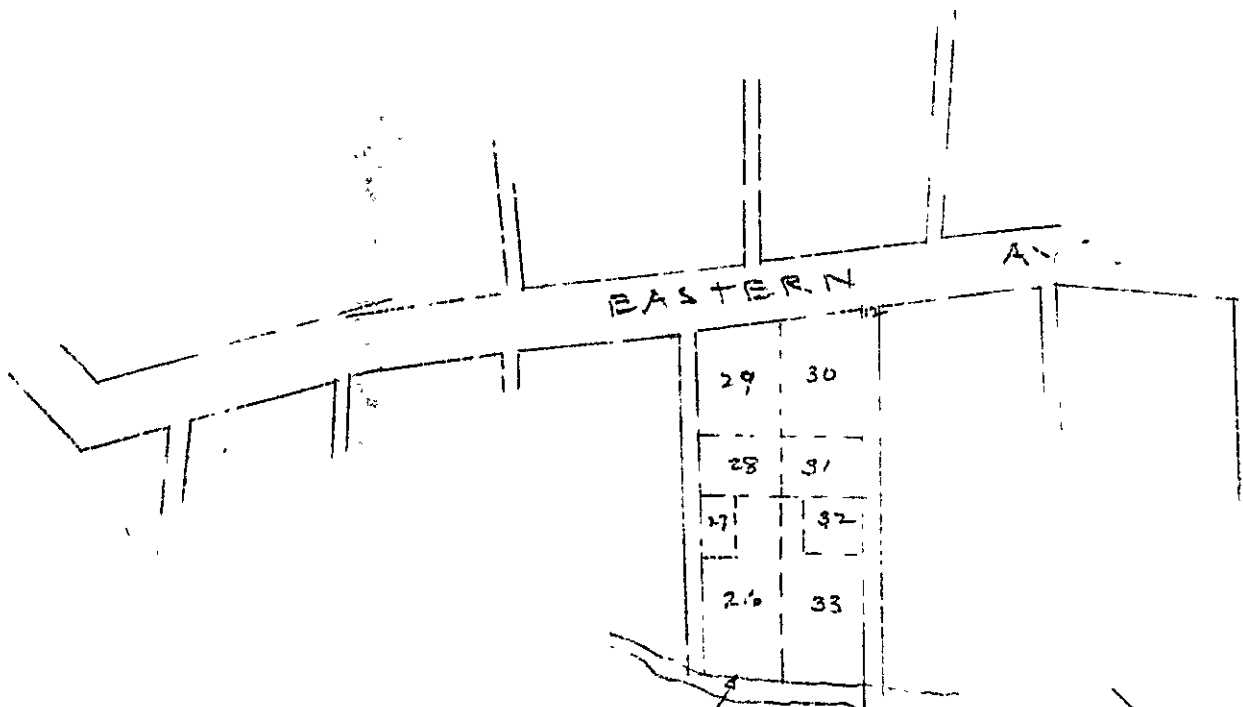

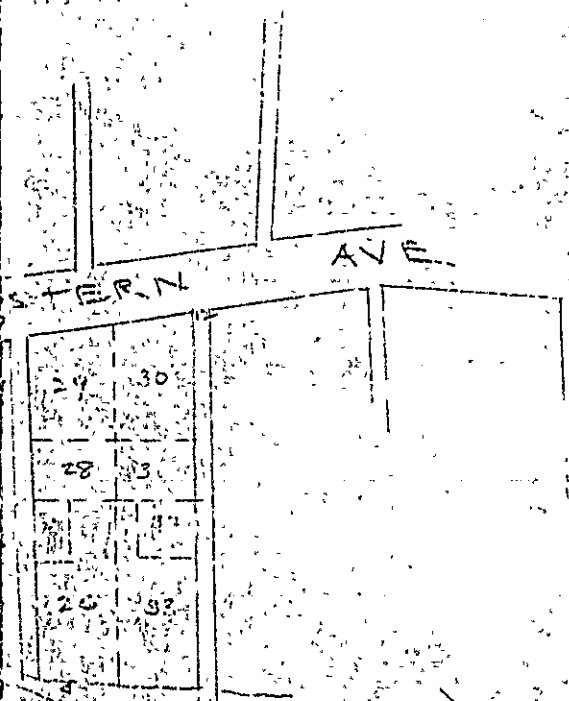
