We have received your Building Permit # 0293, for replacing the porch on the rear of our cottage on Long Island. Thank you for your promptness.

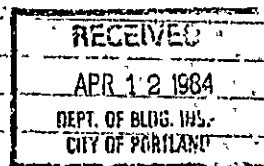
There is one discrepancy, however: Your permit specifies Lot 96-D-7, on Beach Ave. We sold that property last summer to a Carl Barter, of Portland.

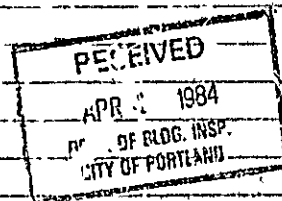

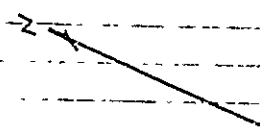

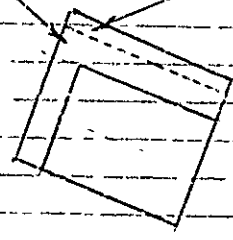
Cargo

Existing Porch      Proposed Addition

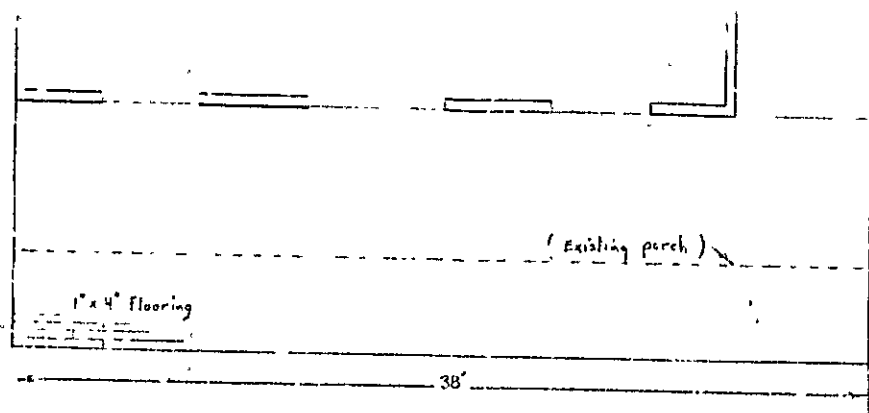
